- ❖ To investigate and report all the accident, disease, poisoning and dangerous occurrence in the workplace as well as take steps to ensure that such incidents do not recur;
- ❖ To comply with legal requirements and other needs regarding occupational safety and health;
- ❖ To set occupational safety and health objective targets and planning programs towards the achievement of those objectives;
- ❖ To provide welfare facilities for all employees; and
- ❖ To review this policy and Occupational Safety and Health Management System when necessary.

This Department is confident that safety and health must be integrated into our daily activities and cultivating a safe and healthy way of working is a key factor towards ensuring the success of the Department's mission.
