- Root: for postpartum mother, treats cough and diarrhea
- Leaves: treat diarrhea

- Skin: for fever and diarrhea treatment

Method

Root extract is consumed. The leaf decoction is consumed. The roots, bark, and leaves are turned into ointment. Bark decoction is consumed orally.
