## 1. TELAGA TUJUH

Telaga Tujuh, or the Seven Wells waterfall, is so named because there are seven natural pools that are connected by a single river. Located within the Machinchang Forest Reserve on the island of Langkawi, Kedah, the waterfalls are divided into two sections – the upper and lower pools.

The view here is truly a sight to behold and the richness of the biodiversity in the forest reserve is fantastic. If you're lucky, you may even get to see some animals, such as hornbills and macaques.

Don't worry about having to hike through the thick forest because there are stairs – 300 of them – you can take that will lead you to the different pools. It's a rejuvenating retreat to wash your troubles away. Remember to wear appropriate footwear (sports or hiking shoes are recommended) when you visit Telaga Tujuh, and of course, do bring a change of clothes too.
